All items must be sorted, clean and dry. We will not accept unsorted recycling.

These are the only un-numbered rigid plastics we will accept. **Please group these into separate categories and put into separate bags or containers.**

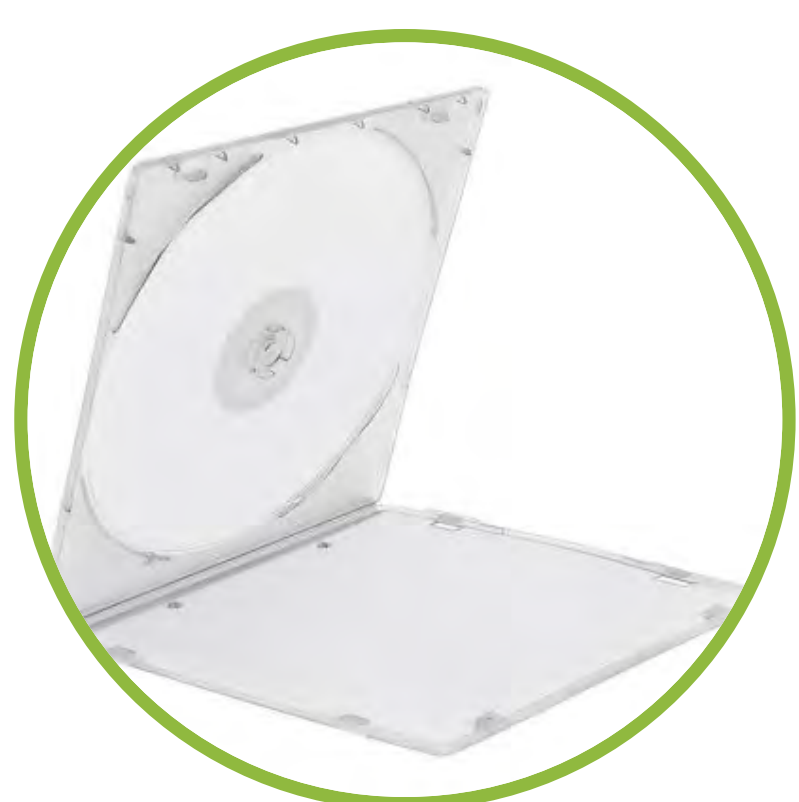

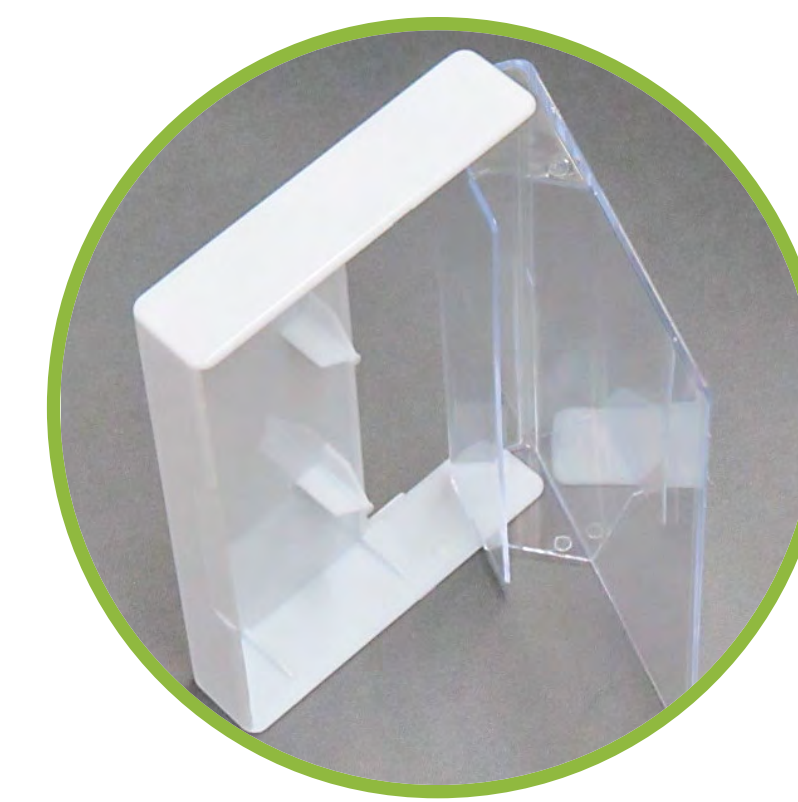

Numbered Items

All other items must be marked with recycling numbers 2, 4, 5 or 6 and be sorted by number (ie place all #2 together, all #4 together, all #5 together, all #6 together) Put each number into a separate bag or container. Below are some examples of numbered plastics:

Cords and string lights

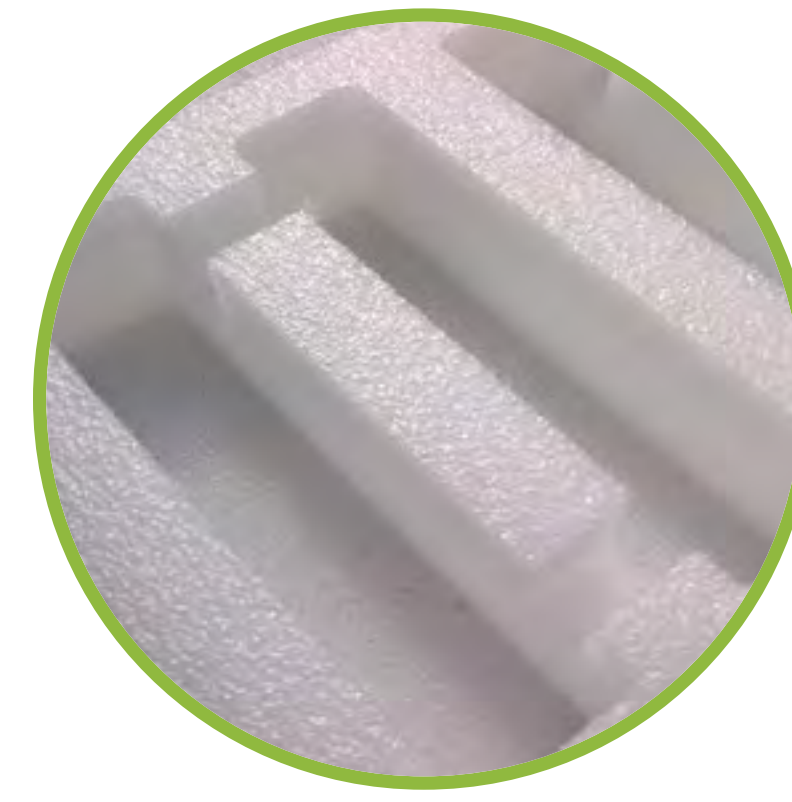
